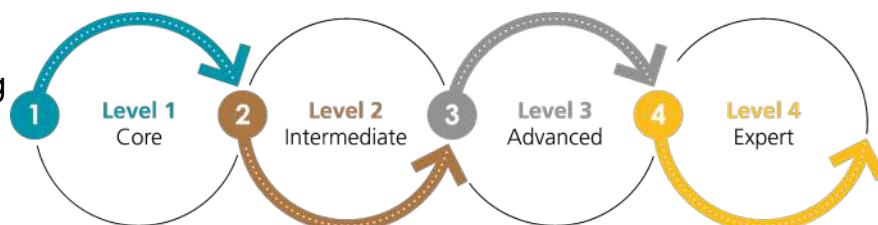


Level 1 Acute Oncology e-learning with Competence Assessment Passport

The UK Acute Oncology Competence Assessment Passports aim to promote the development of a knowledgeable, skilled, and competent workforce that treats and cares for people with an acute oncology indication.

The Passports cover four levels of Acute Oncology knowledge and skills competence, aligning with the UKONS Acute Oncology Knowledge and Skills Guidance.



Working with the CASCADE (Co-design of Acute Oncology Standardised Competence Assessment Documents and their Evaluation) project team, Macmillan Cancer Support have developed and launched the Level 1 Acute Oncology e-learning Passport, which supports learners with core level competencies.

To support the pilot of the Acute Oncology Passport at Level 1, complete the pre-course survey, the e-learning module and the post-course survey.
