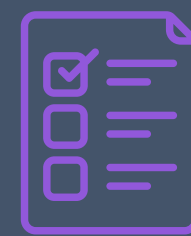

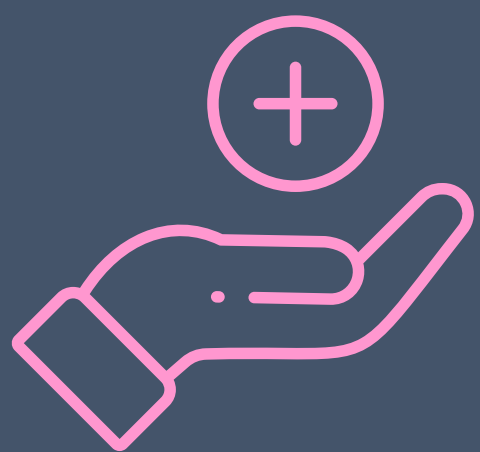

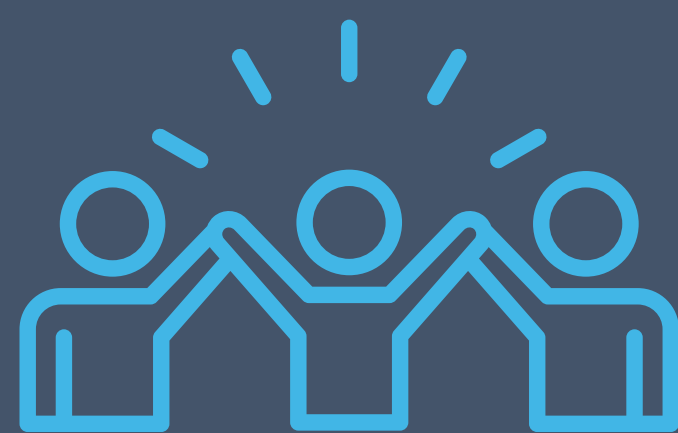
Functionality

Appraisal Dashboard

User's progress with the ACCEND Framework will be displayed in a personal dashboard, with the option to set personal milestones and 12-month goals, supporting meaningful appraisal discussions.

Registered staff will have the option to choose specific timeframes of logged CPD and export them as evidence for NMC revalidation.
